Check your pay stubs on Skyward!! Did you get your 3% raise this year? Did you get your retro pay? Did you get both of your Q-Comp stipends? All payment adjustments should be finalized on your checks by now. Also, everybody is on a 24 pay period now. Here are the important dates and payment that goes with them:

September 29th: \$300 Q-Comp

October 13th: Your 3% should have been add-

ed in for all checks going forward

October 31st: \$250 Q-Comp

November 15th: Retro pay for first three checks of the year.
