Check Your Pay Stub

Check your pay stubs on Skyward! Did you get your QComp Stipend on September 30th? Are you being paid the correct amount? Take your pay and times by 24 and check the salary schedule in the contract. Should you be getting longevity? Check that too. It is important to check your pay stub at least every so often to make sure you are being compensated for all that you do.

Also, as long as you are in Skyward....

Take a few minutes to review your personal information. It is very important that your name, social security number, and address are correct, as this is the information that will be used to complete your W-2 tax form. Also your December 31 paystub will have your year to date for union dues.

Check Your Seniority!

The 2024 seniority list came out. **Check to be sure your information is correct!** This includes seniority date (start date), seniority credits, licensure and license expiration date. Report any discrepancies to HR immediately.

Your seniority information is especially important. This information will be used in the bidding process beginning in the spring.
