Contract Corner

Spring 2025 Staffing Timeline:

Round 1:

Opens - Friday, February 28, 2025 at 10:00AM
Closes - Wednesday, March 5, 2025 - Typically around 4:00PM

Round 2:

Opens - Friday, March 7, 2025 at 10:00AM (This is the Friday before Spring Break!)
Closes - Saturday, March 15, 2025 - Typically around 4:00PM

Any remaining open positions posted - approximately Wednesday, March 19, 2025

How to submit a bid?

Bids are submitted electronically using an online bidding system. Round 1 and 2 openings are sent out by HR through email. Use the link provided in the email to bid on positions you are interested in. You may select your first, second and third choice, etc.

Who can or cannot bid?

- Teachers who have completed 4 years in 622 can bid.
- You may not bid on a position if you do not hold the required license.
- Teachers do not have the right to bid into other teaching positions during the first four years of employment without approval of the current and prospective building administrator.
- Teachers who are currently on an improvement plan do not have the right to bid.
- Tier 1 and Tier 2 licensed teachers do not have the right to bid.

How are bids awarded?

Positions will be awarded to the bidder with the highest seniority. If a teacher has super seniority for any reason, they would be awarded the new position over a teacher with regular seniority. If both teachers have super seniority then the position is awarded to the teacher with the highest regular seniority.
The timing of submitting a bid DOES NOT MATTER as long as bidding is open.

403b Match

If you are not already taking advantage of the 403b match, you need to sign up asap. The District will match up to 3.6% of your salary. You need to contribute at least 3.6% to receive the entire match. At any time throughout the year you can increase or change your contribution by simply filling out the change form. One of the benefits of increasing your contribution is that it lowers your taxable income.
